We will continue to build upon the successes we have had during the 2014-2015 school year and are excited to see what this year will reveal.

As the school year begins, we can always count on one thing: traffic congestion. Door A is always the most congested, so you may want to drop off or pick up at other locations. I encourage families to utilize the new parent drop off area behind the school: Door J (by the Fieldhouse). Families should enter by the community pool lot off of Fisher Street or Lions Club Drive and continue to travel behind the school until door J is reached. Vehicles should turn around here and return back to Fisher Street in order to exit the campus. To avoid frustration from traffic congestion, I would encourage all parents to use our new drop off area listed above and to arrive early. Students who park in the South lot will only be allowed to enter this lot off of Columbia Ave.

The 2015-2016 school year will bring with it a modified schedule from previous years. Munster High School will continue forward with a 7-period day for students, but a homeroom (Mustang Resource Time) period will be added to lunches. When students receive their schedules at registration, they will see that classes are listed in slots 1-8. Please be mindful that one of these slots is for lunch/M.R.T. Students can still take up to 7 classes.

In an attempt to maintain Munster's status as an excellent school system, the high school examined bell schedules used by other high-performing high schools, specifically Adlai E. Stevenson High School in Lincolnshire, IL. Our schedule modification will add 20 minutes onto the school day for students and will carry with it additional benefits for all.

Lunches will exist in periods 4, 5, and 6. Students will have lunch and Mustang Resource Time during one of these periods and courses during the other two. Munster High will look to utilize this M.R.T. period for various purposes. At a minimum, all students will have about 20 minutes a day to work on homework, study, or visit the Media Center. Students will have access to school announcements at this time, and it is our hope that students can meet with school counselors and administrators during this time so that missed class time is limited. This will also provide us with an opportunity to survey students regarding school initiatives as we strive for continued improvement. We will also implement a resource time for students struggling in English and math so that they can receive some extra assistance during the school day. Our hope is that we can provide assistance when it is most needed so that students are able to be successful.

RESIDENTS WILL NEED A MINIMUM OF FOUR ITEMS TO PROVE RESIDENCY:

- **Mortgage statement, settlement statement, or property tax receipt with the name(s) of the homeowners or a lease (must be current) indicating the term of the lease, address of the lease property, name and phone number of the lessor, name of the lessee and a listing of tenants**

and TWO of the following. All must be current (dated within the last two months.)

- **Town of Munster water bill**
- **NIPSCO bill**
- **Auto insurance bill**
- **Bank statement**
- **Telephone bill**
- **Pay stub with address**

School Town of Munster Student Nutrition & Food Services has a NEW Director

It is with great pleasure that Kathryn Feezel, the new Student Nutrition & Food Services Director joins the School Town of Munster team. "Your children's wellness is my top priority as I begin to lead the School Town of Munster's excellent Food Service Department."

2015-16 MEAL PRICES


MEAL DEAL LUNCH is \$2.45; Second Lunch is \$2.65; Breakfast MEAL DEAL \$1.30. Ala Carte options available at additional cost.

DIETARY PRESCRIPTION FORM USDA requires that a completed Dietary Prescription form be on file for any meal changes. If your child follows doctor's orders for a special diet or a food allergy, meal substitutions, where possible, will be made in the cafeteria. Substitutions cannot be made without this completed form on file. Forms can be found on the School Town of Munster website and at all schools. Completed forms must be returned to the school nurse's office. These forms will then be shared with the Nutrition & Food Services Department. USDA has ruled that water or juice is no longer permitted as a milk substitution. **Lactose free, unflavored, fat free milk must be the only substitute.**

MEAL ASSISTANCE APPLICATIONS New applications for free or reduced priced meals and textbook assistance are available on the school website or at school offices. Households **MUST** complete a new application each year. Last year's application will carry over for lunch assistance the first 30 days of school **OR** until a new application has been processed. Only 1 application per household is required. All households will be notified by mail.

REGISTRATION The Student Nutrition & Food Service Department will once again be available at all school registrations for your convenience. You may make pre-payment deposits onto your student(s) meal account and turn in meal assistance applications at registration. Menus, meal assistance applications and other important information will be available as well. Payments in the form of personal checks will **ONLY** be taken at registration. We look forward to seeing you there!

REMINDER The high school has a **"No Charge Policy"**. Students must have money on their account to make purchases or pay with cash. Deposits may be made in the lunch line (*checks payable to MHS*) or by visiting www.myschoolbucks.com for more on line payment information. Parents should be aware students can go through money very quickly if they purchase extra items or second lunches on a regular basis. *Meal and ala carte purchases are between parents and students.* Parents may check lunch balances when accessing student information through the PowerParent Portal. The student balance shown here is always one day behind.

ATHLETIC PHYSICALS

An athlete must have a physical examination between April 1 and the first day of a sports camp or try out date. **A new physical is required each year.** An athlete **MAY NOT** try out, attend a sports camp, or practice for any team unless the IHSAA pre-participation physical evaluation form is on file in the athletic office. A physician must sign the form. Physicals signed by a nurse practitioner **WILL NOT** be accepted and the athlete will not be allowed to participate. This is a requirement of the IHSAA. Athletes and Parents also need to sign the Concussion/Sudden Cardiac Arrest form.

Physical forms can be picked up in the athletic office or on line at www.munster.us. The office hours are between 7:30 a.m. – 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. Please be sure that all information and student/guardian signatures are complete. Having to return physicals for information or signatures could delay your child from trying out or practicing with the rest of the team.

Press Release

The Munster High School Speech and Debate Team attended the Indiana State Board of Education meeting on July 1st in Indianapolis, Indiana. Munster Speech and Debate was invited by alumnus and Vice Chair, Sarah O'Brien (Fine). Munster presented an overview on competitive speech and debate, the history of the program, and highlighted this past season's

accomplishments. Munster had two successful national tournaments. On May 23-24 the team competed in Fort Lauderdale, Florida at the NCFL Grand National Tournament. Vivian Reba placed 4th in the nation in Prose/Poetry. On June 15 to June 19 the team traveled to Dallas, Texas to compete in the NSDA National Tournament. The team had several students advance including Nia Clark, an octafinalist in Dramatic Interpretation; Kendra Williams, a quarterfinalist in Dramatic Interpretation. Allison Hemingway and Chloe Zatorski, quarterfinalists in Duo Interpretation; William McDunn, a quarterfinalist in Original Oratory; and Charles DeCesaris and Vijai Dharla, octafinalists in Public Forum Debate. Peyton Tinder placed 11th in the nation in Humorous Interpretation, and she was named an auto-qualifier to the 2016 National Tournament in Salt Lake City, Utah. Madison Switalla placed 3rd in the nation in Extemporaneous Debate and earned a scholarship. Rohan Chatterjee won the National Final Round earning the "Bama Bowl" scholarship sponsored by the University of Alabama. Rohan was named the National Runner-Up with his humorous satire on privacy rights and the role of government. Overall, the Speech and Debate team repeated earning the School of Outstanding Distinction Award, an award given to the top ten teams in the nation. Munster HS was the only Midwest team in the top ten.

The Munster High School Speech and Debate Team will hold its 45th annual Chicken Barbecue Dinner before the Homecoming Game on Friday, September 11, 2015 in the Food Court between 4:30 and 6:30 p.m. Carry outs will also be available.

Tickets for the dinner may be purchased from Speech and Debate Team members during their door-to-door drive or at the high school office until tickets are sold out.

The cost of tickets for adults is \$9.00; senior citizens, 62 and older, \$8.00; and children under 12, \$6.00. All tickets must be purchased in advance. There will be no tickets sold at the door.

Team members will be selling door-to-door in the community on Saturday, August 23, from 9:30 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. and Sunday, August 24, from 12:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

All proceeds from the Chicken Barbecue Dinner will be used to fund the activities of the Speech and Debate Team for the current year.
