GENERAL INFORMATION

❖ DATES

All Classes will be held MONDAY- THURSDAY. NO FRIDAY CLASSES

- **Classes** begin Monday, June 4, 2018, and end Thursday, July 12, 2018.
Please note we will not be in session on Wednesday, July 4th, 2018.

❖ TIMES: Please note the start time and end time for 2018

- Session #1 7:15 a.m. - 10:15 a.m.
Session #2 10:45 a.m. – 1:45 p.m.

❖ Lunch Break

A 30-minute lunch break will be provided for students taking both summer session classes. Snack options will be available in the Mustang Corral, and students are welcome to bring a lunch.

❖ ATTENDANCE: Absences and Tardies

To receive credit during summer school, a student may not have more than **four (4) attendance infractions**. An absence from class and/or a tardy to class is considered an infraction. Of these four infractions, **only two (2) can be absences**. At the third absence, the student will be dropped from the class. If a student reaches **five (5) infractions**, he or she will also be dropped from the class. A student is absent if he/she misses more than twenty (20) minutes of class; less than twenty minutes will be considered a tardy.

NOTE:

1. **There is no need to call off your son/daughter when absent or tardy. There are no differences between unexcused, excused absence and/or tardies during summer school.**
2. **A student who is removed or withdraws from a summer school class will not receive credit for the course.**

❖ REPORT CARDS:

Will be available upon request. A final grade print out can be provided.

❖ REFUNDS: Money for summer school courses is **NOT** refundable if a student drops a class or is removed from a class on or after June 4, 2018.

❖ **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

All rules and regulations for the regular school year are also in effect for summer school; however discipline for summer school will consist of warnings and/or removal from summer school. The following rules apply specifically to summer school:

SMOKING: Automatic drop from summer school includes vaping

SHOES: Students are not to go without foot apparel in the building for obvious health and safety reasons. Those who persist in violating this rule will be warned and then dropped from the class.

DRESS: Students who are inappropriately dressed for school will be sent home to change clothes. **The time missed will count as an absence.**

BREAKS: During breaks and before classes begin, students may only be in the Food Court or Commons. **STUDENTS MAY NOT TAKE food or drinks into the classrooms or carpeted areas.**

PARKING: Students are not allowed to park in teacher parking lots.

INSUBORDINATION: Automatic drop from summer school
