YOUTH CONSERVATION CORPS-INDIANA NATIONAL DUNES LAKESHORE SUMMER EMPLOYMENT: The Indiana Dunes National Lakeshore is pleased to announce that it is continuing its commitment to the Youth Conservation Corps (YCC) for the summer of 2018. The YCC program offers an exciting and rewarding opportunity for youths to earn money, gain experience, and enhance environmental awareness working for the National Park Service. Indiana Dunes National Lakeshore anticipates employing approximately eight youths in the program this summer. Participants will be involved primarily in outside, labor-type activities that may include trail construction, custodial, maintenance, grounds keeping and painting. Employment will begin June 3 and last ten weeks, through August 11.

Participants must provide their own transportation to/from the worksite. Work schedules include working 40 hours a week, and may include Saturdays, Sundays and holidays. Meals are not provided.
