

## Uncharged Battery Policy

The battery in the computer should last well past 5<sup>th</sup> period with normal use after receiving a full charge.

3<sup>rd</sup> Battery before 5<sup>th</sup> Period – Detention Assigned

4<sup>th</sup> Battery before 5<sup>th</sup> Period – Saturday School Assigned

5<sup>th</sup> Battery before 5<sup>th</sup> Period – In School Suspension Assigned

6<sup>th</sup> Battery before 5<sup>th</sup> Period – Out of School Suspension Assigned &
